

History - In the mid 1700's, pastor and theologian Jonathan Edwards coined the term "concerts of prayer" to describe corporate gatherings of Christians for intercession and spiritual renewal. These meetings eventually became a spark for the First Great Awakening in the United States and much more. Throughout history, focused prayer efforts of this kind have led to extensive renewal and expansion of the Christian faith in the USA and around the globe.

Concerts of Prayer have often referred to large gatherings of believers from various occupations, denominations, institutions, ministries, generations, and social scales. The current emphasis at Park Place Church, however, is to:

- 1. Bring our congregation together to ask God to bless us with the *fullness* of Christ in our personal lives and in our midst; and
- 2. To equip us to participate in the *fulfillment* of God's global cause to reconcile to himself some from every people group, beginning in our own neighborhood.

Concerts of Prayer is an exciting and effective means of multiplying and uniting the pray-ers in our congregation. *Blending our hearts, minds, and voices in faith* helps us grow in Christ and become involved in God's activity of reconciling men, women, and young people to himself.

Concerts of Prayer are marked by *a spirit of celebration and anticipation* of all that God will do in response to his people coming together in prayer. Rejoicing in hope, we ask God to answer our prayers for spiritual renewal and to equip us to take part in the developing outreach.

The following page explains how to conduct a Concert of Prayer with a small group. It is our hope that small groups throughout the congregation will consider using this guide for a season of prayer from time-to-time during their meetings.

In addition, we encourage individuals to consider using the prayer guide suggestions during personal times of worship and prayer.

God delights to hear and to answer the prayers of his children.

Let us intercede in harmony that God may be glorified and that we may experience all God has promised.

HOW IT WORKS

- 1. Quickly organize into groups of about 6-8 persons.
- 2. Greet each other briefly, but let's focus on talking to God.
- 3. Use the attached **Prayer Guide** to help concentrate on God's agenda for his people, for the ministries of Park Place Church, for ministries supported by PPC, and for all peoples of the earth.
- 4. Everyone in the group read silently through the pages of the **Prayer Guide**.
 - When you feel led to pray about a particular issue listed on the **Guide** (or something related), simply close your eyes and lead out in prayer.
 - Everyone will join you in prayer.
 - \circ After you have prayed, others may want to pray about the same concern.
 - When prayer ceases, read from the **Guide** again until another person begins to pray.
 - ...and so on.

PRAYER SUGGESTIONS & REMINDERS

Green Heading (p. 1) – <u>Awakening, Renewal, Fullness</u> – As we follow Jesus, we become like him. Let's ask him to refresh and renew each one of us for the life and ministries to which he has called us.

Green Heading $(p. 2) - \underline{\text{Discipleship}}$, Advancement, Fulfillment – Jesus is the blessing God promised to his people, and through them, to all peoples of the earth. Let's ask God to guide our efforts to make Christ known throughout our community, and globally through our mission's efforts.

Blue Heading (p. 3-4) – <u>Park Place & Partner Ministries / Park Place Missionaries</u> – Ask God to give us wisdom and vision to support ministries in our congregation and those we assist in our community, and around the globe.

Take your sheet home and continue to pray for personal spiritual growth and the ministries and outreach of Park Place Church of God

CONCERTS OF PRAYER

TO EXPERIENCE GOD'S Awakening - Renewal - Fullness

Jesus Christ was formed in our likeness, that we might become like him through the process of spiritual formation, where our walk with Him cannot be shaken, where the testing of our faith will only make it stronger, to place us securely and permanently in a position of faith, a situation of blessing, and a condition of love and peace.

- 3. That we might experience the joy of salvation as we follow and obey the Lord Jesus.

- 5. That, like Jesus, we will love and forgive those who have wounded or betrayed us.
- 6. That we always put God first in our lives above all else including spouse, children, and work.
- 7. To understand that God owns all we have, and that we are earthly stewards of Kingdom resources.
- 8. To understand that God's agenda is to change our hearts and minds and not to simply release us from trials.
- 9. To grow in Christ and die to self even though it may cause us to suffer in this world.
- 10. That, like Jesus, we will become constantly mindful of what is real and eternal and what is not.
- 11. That the Lord would lead us to fully express God's love in our homes, our work, and our communities.
- 12. For God to help us stand for the truth and against lies, injustice, and unrighteousness in all situations.

- 13. That God will give us the determination and the power to accomplish what he has called us to do.
- 14. That we would be filled with victorious optimism in showing God's love for everyone.
- 15. That we bring love and peace into the division, anger, and hatred so rampant in our world today.
- 16. That God bring true Christian revival to us personally, to our church, to our nation and our world.
- 17. That God will stir us to be alert, active, and enthusiastic about helping others to know him.
- 18. That others see in us love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.
- 19. That the Lord will strengthen our hearts, our minds, and our resolve to be fully committed to him.
- 20. That God would give us a clear vision of his Holiness and righteousness, that we may be like him.
- 21. That the spiritual forces of evil in this world will have no power over us and our families.
- 22. That we would re-awaken to the universal authority of Christ and follow him with courage and strength.
- 23. That our hearts would reflect the heart of God for everyone to know him in and through Jesus Christ.
- 24. That we would become transparent before God and each other in repentance and forgiveness.
- 25. To reject a spirit of fear and receive the spirit of power, love, and sound judgement God promised.
